

THE IOWA FALL MEETING WAS HELD THIS PAST WEEKEND SEPT. 16-18 AT DAYTON OAKS CAMP NEAR DAYTON IN WEBSTER COUNTY. APPROXIMATELY 50 WERE IN ATTENDANCE AND FIELD TRIPS WERE MADE TO DOLLIVER STATE PARK, BRUSHY CREEK AREA AND CARLSON WILDLIFE AREA ^{WHICH PRODUCED A TOTAL OF 106 SPECIES} THE BEST BIRD WAS A FLYOVER BLACK-BILLED MAGPIE AT DOLLIVER S.P. ON SEPT. 18. NINE Raptor SPECIES WERE SEEN DURING THE WEEKEND, INCLUDING 4 SWAINSON'S HAWKS. 15 WARBLERS WERE COUNTED INCLUDING GOLDEN-WINGED, CAPE MAY AND CONNECTICUT. OTHER GOOD BIRDS WERE CAROLINA + WINTER WREN, AND CLAY-COLORED SPARROW

OTHER NW IOWA REPORTS WERE OF 2 BIRDS NOT ^{OR TENSEN SEEN} IN THE STATE. ON SEPT 14 AN IMMATURE WESTERN Tanager WAS FOUND IN A WOODED AREA AT THE EAST EDGE OF SPENCER IN CLAY COUNTY. AND ALSO ON SEPT 14 A PRARIE FALCON WAS OBSERVED AT RUSH LAKE IN PALO ALTO COUNTY 7 MILES NORTH OF LAURENS. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT IN FEBRUARY A PRARIE FALCON WAS SEEN FOR SEVERAL DAYS IN THE SAME GENERAL AREA, AND THAT EARLIER THIS SUMMER AN IMMATURE BIRD

WAS FOUND DEAD IN NW IOWA.

IN CENTRAL IOWA, SEVERAL HUNDRED WHITE PELICANS WERE PRESENT AT SAYLORVILLE LAKE, POLK CO, ON SEPT 17.

AND AT NENDRICKSON MARSH IN SE STORY COUNTY ON SEPT 18 10 SPECIES OF SHOEBIRDS, ALONG WITH FORSTER'S & CASPIAN TERNS.

IN SE IOWA ON THE 16TH AN IMMATURE BLACK CROWNED NIGHT HERON WAS SEEN AT THE SUGAR BOTTOM AREA OF THE CORALVILLE RESERVOIR AND 62 CASPIAN TERNS WERE COUNTED AT THE SANDY BEACH AREA, ~~THE~~ A PINE WARBLER WAS PRESENT NEAR IOWA CITY AND A SHARP SHINNED HAWK HAS BEEN SEEN REGULARLY IN THE EVENING NEAR THE PARKING LOT OF THE IOWA CITY TENNIS CLUB NEAR THE JCT OF I-80 AND MIWAH / 1. AT ELLIS PARK IN C.R. AN OSPREY HAS BEEN SEEN ON SEPT 14 & 16.
