ONLY 2 REPORTS WERE RECEIVED THIS WEEK, BOTH FROM THE JOWA CITY AREA. AT HICKORY HILL PARK A LONG EARED OWL ON OCTOBER 11TH AND A LATE MORNING WARBLER ON THE 12TH.

AT THE CORALVILLE RESERVOIR IN JOHNSON CO, ON THE 15TH A NUMBER OF SHOREBIRDS ARE STILL PRESENT, BUT MOST ARE PECTORAL SAND-PIPERS AND KILLEDEER. AN INTERESTING OBSERVATION ^{AT THE COR RES} OF 50 STARLINGS SOARING IN TANDEM WITH A RED TAILED HAWK FOR 20-30 MINUTES ON THE 16TH, AT THE SANDY BEACH AND TWIN VIEW HEIGHTS AREA, 6 BONAPARTE'S GULLS WITH THE RING BILLED AND NUMEROUS WATER PIDITS, AND 2 OSPREYS.
