

THE FIRST WINTER LITTLE GULL WHICH WAS REPORTED FROM THE JESTER PARK AREA OF THE SAVYLOREVILLE RESERVOIR IN POLK COUNTY ON THURSDAY OCTOBER 27, HAS NOT BEEN RELOCATED DESPITE NUMEROUS WEEKEND EFFORTS. HOWEVER THERE ARE MANY GULLS IN THE AREA, AND IT MAY STILL BE PRESENT. DURING THE SEARCH ON SUNDAY OCTOBER 30TH A RED-THROATED LOON WAS DISCOVERED JUST OFF OF THE BOAT LAUNCH AREA AT JESTER PARK. OTHER BIRDS SEEN OVER THE WEEKEND AT SAVYLOREVILLE INCLUDED 5 WHITE-WINGED SCOTERS, UP TO 80 COMMON LOONS, 30-40 HORNED GREBES, 5 GEARLINS GULLS AND NUMEROUS BONAPARTES GULLS.

ALSO IN CENTRAL IOWA, THE RED-SHOULDERED HAWK WAS STILL PRESENT IN HAROLD COUNTY 5 MILES WEST OF UNION AND JUST NORTH OF COUNTY ROAD D-65.

IN NE IOWA, A NORTHERN SHRIKE WAS OBSERVED NEAR BELLEVUE IN JACKSON COUNTY ON THE 27TH.

IN SE IOWA <sup>NORTH OF</sup> BURLINGTON IN DM COUNTY 2 WHITE-WINGED SCOTERS AND 2 BLACK SCOTERS AS WELL AS A COMMON LOON AND BONAPARTES GULL WERE SEEN ON THE 30TH IN THE POOL ABOVE LOCK & DAM #18. FOR MORE INFORMATION ON THESE BIRDS CALL CHUCK KAUFER AT (319) 753-0710
