On August 1st, a white immature Little Blue Heron was found among about 40 Great Egrets at the Coraeville Reservoir. These birds were located in flooded fields north of the Swan Lake Road and about a half mile west of Swan Lake. There are quite a few shorebirds at Coraeville, but scattered over a large area.

At Saylorville Reservoir, 38 white pelicans were counted about 3 1/4 miles north of the Highway 17 bridge on the 29th.

And 81 House Finches nested and raised 3 young at 807 Sunapee in New Hampton

IN CENTRAL IOWA AT THE COLO PARKS IN Story COUNTY 2 CATTLE EGRETS AND 8 SHOREBIRDS SPECIES INCLUDED WILSON'S PHALAROPE AND STILT SANDPIPER ON THE 29TH.

TO THE SOUTHEAST, AT THE CASEY-BEARROW LANDING OF THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER ABOUT 10 MILES NORTH OF BURLINGTON, A LEAST TERN AND A SANDERLING ON THE 29TH. AT THE OLD GOLF COURSE AT LACEY-KEE SPURGEON STATE PARK IN VAN BUREN COUNTY A WHITE EYED VIREO ON THE 28TH. IN JEFFERSON COUNTY 10 SPECIES OF SHOREBIRDS AT THE CORACONNE RESERVOIR INCLUDING STILT SANDPIPER AND SHORT BILLED DOWITCHER, AND 2 WHITE PELICANS ^{AND AN ASIATIC} ON THE 29TH. ALONG THE MUSCATINE JEFFERSON COUNTY LINE ROAD SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 6, A普LAND SANDPIPER AND GRAY PINTAIL ON THE 28TH.
