

THERE HAVE BEEN FEW REPORTS OF WARBLERS, AND NO LARGE NUMBERS OF SPECIES OR UNUSUAL SPECIES THE PAST WEEK. THE BEST BIRDS ARE 2 WHITE FACED IBIS IN GUTHRIE COUNTY.

REPORTS FROM CENTRAL IOWA, 2 WHITE FACED IBIS AT THE NORTH END OF BAY'S BRANCH IN GUTHRIE COUNTY ON MAY 5TH. ALSO SEEN THERE WERE BIRD'S SANDPIPER, DUNLIN, WHITE RUMPED SANDPIPER, LONG AND SHORT BILLED DOWITCHER AND WILLET. ALSO IN GUTHRIE COUNTY AT LAKES SLOUGH, A FEMALE GREAT TAILED GRACKLE AND A BLACK CROWNED NIGHT HERON ON THE 6TH. AT THE BEACH OF SANDPIPER RECREATION AREA OF THE SPALDING RESERVOIR IN POLK COUNTY CASPIAN AND FORSTNER'S TERN, BONAPARTE'S GULL, SANDPELIL, PIPING PLOVER LONG BILLED DOWITCHER, WILLET, AND DUNLIN ^{ON THE 5TH & 6TH} AND AT BIG CREEK STATE PARK A LINGERING COMMON LOON ON THE 6TH. A LATE ROUGH LEGGED HAWK WAS SEEN IN BOONE COUNTY ON THE 5TH, AND COOPER'S HAWKS ARE NESTING AT WOODLAND MOUNDS PRESERVE IN WARREN COUNTY. IN STORY COUNTY, AT COLD POND 8 SPECIES OF SHOREBIRDS INCLUDING LESSER GOLDEN PLOVER AND DOWITCHER. AND A HUDSONIAN GODWIT AT LARSON MARSH ON THE 2ND. AN INJURED BARN OWL WAS RECOVERED NEAR SWAN IN MARION COUNTY ON APRIL 30TH.
