IN SOUTHEAST IOWA, THE SMITH'S AND LALAND
LONGSPURS WERE STILL PRESENT AT THE LOCATION IN
JOHNSON COUNTY WHERE THEY WERE FIRST IDENTIFIED
ON MARCH 24, AND ALSO WERE DISCOVERED IN
DES MOINES COUNTY. TO LOOK FOR THE JOHNSON COUNTY
BIRDS, FROM THE NORTH EDGE OF LOVE TREE, GO WEST
ON HIGHWAY 22 1 MILE THEN NORTH ON GRAVEL 2 MILES
AND LESS THAN A HALF MILE EAST AND LOOK IN THE
FIELD ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE ROAD WITH LARGE
ROUND GRASS BLENDS. YOU MAY HAVE TO WALK INTO THE
FIELD. GRAY PARTRIDGE WERE ^{ALSO} SEEN IN THAT AREA ON
THE 7TH. TO SEARCH THE OTHER LOCATION GO NORTH
FROM BURLINGTON ON HIGHWAY 99 TO BETWEEN MILE
MARKERS 9+10, THEN EAST ON GRAVEL 2 MILES
AND NORTH A MILE AND LOOK IN THE FIELD TO THE
NORTHEAST OF THAT INTERSECTION. IN OTHER SOUTHEAST
