FIRST REPORTS OF COMMON MIGRANTS APPEARING IN THE STATE DURING THE PAST WEEK INCLUDED WINTER WREN, HERMIT THRUSH, VENUS RUMPEL WARBLER, AND RUBY CROWNED KINGLET OFF CHIPPING SPARROW, A PLUS OTHERS WHICH WILL BE MENTIONED LATER.

In Southeast Iowa, the Smith's and Lazards Longtails were still present at the location in Johnson County where they were first identified on April 8th on March 29, and also were discovered in Des Moines County. To look for the Johnson County Birds, from the north edge of Love Tree, go west on Hiway 22 1 mile then north on gravel 2 miles and less than a half mile east and look in the field on the north side of the road with large round hay bales. You may have to walk into the field. Gray Partridge were ^{also} seen in that area on the 7th. To search the other locations go north from Burlington on Hiway 99 to between mile markers 9+10, then east on gravel 2 miles and north a mile and look in the field to the northeast of that intersection. In other Southeast Iowa reports from Burlington Cross Park winter wren and Hermit Thrush on ~~the 7th~~ and Bonapartes Gulls at Casey Bottom landing north of town on the 7th. At Croton Unit of Shumek State Forest in Lee County, Louisiana Water Tern, winter wren and Rufous sided Towhee on the 6th. A Great Egret at Cove Marsh in Louisa County on the 7th.
