IN NEW NEWS FROM EXTREME SOUTHEAST TOWNS, A NUMBER OF GOOD BIRDS ON THE 14TH AND 15TH. IN VAN BUREN COUNTY, NEAR ~~LACEY~~ KESAUQUA STATE PARK, SCISSOR TAILED FLYCATCHER, HENLOW'S SPARROW, UPLAND SANDPIPER AND SHORT EARED OWL IN LARGE GRASS FIELDS WHERE HENLOW'S SPARROWS HAVE BEEN FOUND THE PREVIOUS TWO YEARS. TO FIND THIS LOCATION FROM HIGHWAY 1 IN KESAUQUA GO WEST ON COUNTY ROAD J-40 FOR 4.7 MILES, THEN SOUTH ON GRAVEL 1.3 MILES AND WEST 5 MILES ^{THE SCISSOR TAILED FLYCATCHER WAS SEEN 2 MI OUT AT} WHERE THE GRASSY FIELDS ~~START~~ AT THE ELY FORD AREA OF LACEY-KESAUQUA STATE PARK KENTUCKY, YELLOW THROATED, CERULEAN AND PARULA WARBLERS, AND ACADIAN FLYCATCHER. AT CROTON UNIT OF SHIMER STATE FOREST IN LEE COUNTY, HOODED AND WORM EATING WARBLERS PLUS OTHER SE TOWNS SPECIALTIES. TO FIND THESE BIRDS, FROM THE TOWN OF ARGYLE GO WEST ABOUT 2 MILES THEN TAKE THE RIGHT FORK AT THE 4 AND GO 1.3 MILES AND PULL OFF JUST BEFORE A SMALL BRIDGE. THE HOODED WARBLER, I SWING UP THE HILL BEHIND WHERE YOU PARK AND THE WORM-EATING WAS A LITTLE WAY INTO THE WOODS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF A TRAIL WHICH GOES EAST FROM WHERE YOU PARK. ON THE WAY LOOK FOR SUMMERTIME

TANAGER NEAR WHERE THE SIGN ENTERING CROTAN
UNIT IS SEEN. THERE ARE YELLOW BREASTED
CHATS CLOSE TO WHERE YOU PARK ALSO OTHER
BIRDS SEEN IN THE WOODS THERE WERE DINE,
KENTUCKY, CERULEAN, AND PARULA WARBLERS,
ACRODINS' FLYCATCHER AND SCARLET TANAGER
FOR MORE INFO ON ANY OF THESE SEE LOUISIANA

THESE. IN A REPORT KRONO LOGO POSED IN STONE
COUNTY, FROM 10-14 SPECIES OF SHOREBIRDS
HAVE BEEN PRESENT EACH OF THE PAST SEVERAL
DAYS INCLUDING 20 HORNED LIMBS AND
3 WILSON'S PHALAROPES ON THE 14TH.

ALSO YELLOW THROAT, BLUET GOLDEN WINGED AND
LOUISIANA WATER THRUSH, BOTH GOLDFIRES IN GREENE COUNTY
ALSO IN CENTRAL IOWA AN AMERICAN BITTERN AT
LAUREN MARSH IN STONE COUNTY ON THE 13TH AND AT
THE BEACH OF SANDPIPER RECREATION AREA OF THE
SAGINAW RIVER 3 RUDDY TURNSTONE, 5 SUMMER-

THE WEEK'S REPORT

WIMBLEDONS HAVE BEEN MUCH MORE NOTICERABLE THIS WEEK, AND 2 WESTERN KINGBIRD REPORTS CAME FROM FARTHER EAST IN THE STATE THAN THEY ARE USUALLY SEEN

In CENTRAL IOWA, WESTERN KINGBIRDS HAVE RETURNED JUST EAST OF DES MOINES FOR A 5TH STRAIGHT YEAR TO THE INTERSECTION OF 70TH STREET NE AND 12TH AVE NE, WHICH IS JUST 1 MILE NORTH OF HIGHWAY 163. ALSO IN POLK COUNTY AT SAYLORVILLE RESERVOIR ON THE 11TH AT SANDPIPER RECREATION AREA BEACH A RUDDY TURNSTONE, SANDPIPER AND PIPING PLOVER, AND AT OAK GROVE BEACH 2 PIPING PLOVERS AND BLACK TEALS ON THE LAKE AT 7TH-COUNTRY LANE ESTATES WHICH IS OFF ANNIVERSARY AVENUE 2-3 MILES WEST OF I-35. AT LONG POND IN EXTREME NORTHEAST BUTTERFIELD COUNTY, 2 CATTLE EGRETS ON THE 11TH. AT COCO POINT IN EASTERN STORY COUNTY SO SHORT BILLED DOWNTAILERS, 90 LESSER GOLDEN PLOVER, 50 COMMON SANDPIPER, A DUNLIN AND 2 HUDSONIAN GODWITS ON THE 12TH. IN HARDIN COUNTY, A WESTERN KINGBIRD EAST OF STEAMBOAT ROCK AND A RED NECKED PHALAROPE ON THE RADCLIFFE SEAWAGE POND BOTH ON THE 11TH. IN MARSHALL COUNTY, AT GRAMMER GROVE PARK 18 WARBLER SPECIES INCLUDING GOLDEN WINGED, BLUE WINGED AND MOURNING, CRAN-COLORED AND LINCOLN'S SPARROWS AND ON THE THURSDAY ON THE 9TH A STILT SANDPIPER NEAR LYSCOMB AND HARVEST, WHITE CROWNED AND CRAN-COLORED

SPARROWS AT THE LISCOMB SWANAGE LAGOON SO THE
15TH.
