IN MADISON COUNTY, EUGENE ARMSTRONG HAS NESTING NORTHERN MOCKINGBIRDS AND UPLAND SANDPIPERS NEAR HIS HOME AND YOU CAN CALL HIM AT (515) 996-2726

② ON THE 12TH IN THE NORTHWEST 3 SPECIES OF RAILS WERE SEEN AT STATELINE MARSH IN KOSUTH COUNTY. 2 KING RAILS WERE NORTH OF THE BLACKTOP, A BLACK RAIL WAS AT THE EAST END OF THE WATER SOUTH OF THE ROAD, AND VIRGINIA RAILS WERE FEEDING YOUNG THERE.

IN LINN COUNTY A PAIR OF NORTHERN PARULIDS WAS ^{AT THE IRVING COOPER NATURE CENTER} ALONG THE SAC & FOX TRAIL SOUTH OF THE BRIDGE.

① ON THE 13TH, IN HAMILTON COUNTY, A BASIC PLUMAGED PACIFIC LOON WAS AT ANDERSON'S LAKE EAST OF JEWELL IN THE EVENING. IN LINN COUNTY, AT PLEASANT CREEK LAKE NORTH OF PALO, AN IMMATURE LITTLE BLUE HERON WAS AT THE SPURGE POND AND A COMMON LOON IN BASIC PLUMAGE WAS ON THE LAKE. ACROSS THE MISSOURI RIVER FROM LEE COUNTY, 2 SNOW EGGS WERE ALONG HIGHWAY 96 SOUTH OF NAUVOO, ILLINOIS, AND IN KOSUTH COUNTY A KING RAIL, 2 VIRGINIA RAILS AND A BLACK CROWNED NIGHT HERON WERE AT STATELINE MARSH

The highlights this week are a KING RAIL in Kossuth County, and a LITTLE BLUE HERON on the Illinois side of the Mississippi River from Lee County.

In the northwest in Kossuth County, a KING RAIL was seen on the 10th at Stateline Marsh on the south side of the blacktop. This area is a mile south of the Minnesota border along county road A-16, two miles west of P-30. At Union Slough NWR, a pair of COMMON MOORHENS, with one sitting on a nest, was seen from the road on the 10th. For more information, call Matt Kenne at (515)295-9620.

In the southeast, across the Mississippi River from Lee County, an adult LITTLE BLUE HERON and an AMERICAN AVOCET were in a wildlife area just south of Nauvoo, Illinois, along hiway 96 on the 9th. In northern Lee County, YELLOW-BREASTED CHATS and BELL'S VIREO were found on the 10th. From the village of Augusta, cross the Skunk River and immediately turn right on Old Quarry Road. Proceed 3.7 miles, and look on the brushy hillside on the left. In Des Moines County in the Big Ditch Area about 12 miles north of Burlington, five shorebird species, including STILT SANDPIPER, were found on the 10th.

In the southwest in Fremont County last week, a SUMMER TANAGER was at the back of the campground at Waubonsie State Park, and two CATTLE EGRETS and an adult BALD EAGLE were at Forney Lake.
