The later passerine migrants are moving through, and YELLOW-RUMPED WARBLERS and WHITE-THROATED SPARROWS seem to be everywhere. No rarities were reported last week.

In the central, thirteen sparrow species, including CLAY-COLORED and LECONTE'S were found in Polk and Warren Counties on the 9th, and a late INDIGO BUNTING was seen on the 8th. In Marshall County at the raptor watch at Grammer Grover Park on the 8th, 138 hawks were recorded, including 26 SWAINSON'S, and on the 9th, there were 94 total hawks, of which 55 were RED-TAILS.

In the southeast in Johnson County, an adult MUTE SWAN was on the Coralville Reservoir north of the Mehaffey Bridge on the 9th. On the 6th, an immature PEREGRINE FALCON was along Greencastle Avenue at the Coralville Reservoir. There were seven WINTER WRENS at Hickory Hill Park in Iowa City on the 3rd, AND A LATE RUBY-THROATED HUMMINGBIRD WAS AT THE
