It appears that the two pelagic birds that were vacationing the past two weeks in Sac County have moved on. The LONG-TAILED JAEGER was last reported at Black Hawk Lake at the town of Lake View on the 14th, and the SABINE'S GULL was last seen at the dredge pond across the road from the southeast corner of the lake on the 15th. Shorebirds on the dredge pond on the 15th included PIPING PLOVER and SANDERLING, while a MERLIN was seen over the south shore of the lake on the 15th. At Tomahawk Marsh, which is along county road M-68, about two and a half miles north of Lake View, there was a CATTLE EGRET on the 15th.

In the central in Hamilton County, the PACIFIC LOON was last reported from Anderson Lake, just east of Jewell, on the 15th. In Tama County, eleven shorebird species, including STILT SANDPIPER, plus a PEREGRINE FALCON, were at Otter Creek Marsh near the east end of the south dike on the 17th. The RED-NECKED PHALAROPE at that location was last found on the 15th. In Marshall County, over a thousand BROAD-WINGED HAWKS were counted passing over Grammer Grove Park on the 18th, and there were nine warbler species there on the 17th. In Polk County, AMERICAN GOLDEN PLOVER and BLACK-BELLIED PLOVER were at the beach of the Sandpiper Recreation Area of the Saylorville Reservoir on the 17th. Jim Fuller
