- ✓ Common Loon--Total of Twelve recorded during the period with six of them found at Beed's Lake State Park, Franklin Co., Apr. 12.
- ✓ Horned Grebe--One at Lock#9, Allamakee Co., March 20 was also seen by Alan Branhagen of Decorah.
- ✓ Eared Grebe--One at Saylorville Res., April 13; two at Little Wall Lake, Hamilton Co., May 13.
- ✓ Am White Pelican--Peak at Saylorville was 180, April 13.
- ✓ Dbl-crested Cormorant--Peak at Saylorville was 350, April 13.
- ✓ Whistling Swan--65, New Albin, Allamakee Co., April 10.
- ✓ Gr. White-fronted Goose--Twenty at New Albin April 10.
- ✓ Greater Scaup--Nine at Lansing, Allamakee Co., Apr. 10; and four at Nashua, Chickasaw Co., April 12. (See doc.)
- ✓ White-winged Scoter--One female at Saylorville April 8. (See doc.)
- ✓ Cooper's Hawk--A large accipiter with orange belly was ^{seen} April 28 at Ames, Story Co..
- ✓ Swainson's Hawk--One at Big Creek S. P., Polk Co., Apr. 15.
- ✓ Rough-legged Hawk--Two were at New Albin, Apr. 10.
- ✓ Golden Eagle--One imm. in extreme e. central Winneshiek Co. on March 20, was also seen by Alan Branhagen.
- ✓ Merlin--One male seen in eastern Winneshiek Co., April 11. (See doc.)
- ✓ Lesser Yellowlegs--Early, Saylorville, Apr. 4.
- ✓ Baird's Sandpiper--Three were seen east of Colo, Story Co., Apr. 24.
- ✓ Alder Flycatcher--Heard at Lansing Wildlife Area, Allamakee Co., May 29.
- ✓ Gray-Cheeked Thrush--Fifteen were seen in Ames May 11-12.
- ✓ Eastern Bluebird--Thirty-five at St. Lucas, Fayette Co., Mar. 16.
- ✓ Water Pipit--Singles at Sweet Marsh, Bremer Co., April 11 and New Albin April 29.
- Out of order → [✓ Kentucky Warbler--Two in Ames May 4 where they are rather uncommon.
- ✓ Northern Shrike--Five were seen in N.E. Iowa March 16-21.
- ✓ White-eyed Vireo--One at Volga Lake R. A. May 18.
- ✓ Worm-eating Warbler--One in Volga Lake R. A. May 18.
- ✓ Brewer's Blackbird--Two at New Albin April 10: One near Waucoma, Fayette Co., Apr. 11.
- ✓ Com. Redpoll--150 still at New Albin March 24.
- ✓ Clay-colored Sparrow--Eleven were found in Ames May 4-12.
- ✓ Smith's Longspur--Around sixty were seen April 1 near Polk City, Polk Co.. (see doc.)
- ✓ Lapland Longspur--Three still in Story Co. Apr. 24.
- ✓ Snow Bunting--Last ~~one~~ observed March 12 when five were found in NW Franklin Co..
