AMERICAN ROBIN		OCT. 26	AT GROCERY STORE I SAW ROBINS MIGRATING SOUTH. WATCHED THEM GOING HOME (1 MILE) AND WATCHED THEM AT HOME UNTIL DARK. FLYING LOW HORIZON TO HORIZON, BUT A LOOSE FLOCK. MORE ROBINS THAN I'VE EVER SEEN TOGETHER.
AMERICAN ROBIN		NOV. 3	ANOTHER MIGRATION, NOT AS LARGE, BUT FLYING MUCH HIGHER THAN THE FIRST OCT. 26 FLOCK.
COMMON GRACKLE	3	NOV. 23	BACKYARD FEEDER. HAD NOT SEEN ANY COM. GRACKLES FOR AWHILE AND THESE 3 MALES CAME IN FOR ONE DAY.
