On the 23rd in the central in Marion County, a RUFF was discovered at the Runnells WA. No further details are known, but since the area is closed, it is assumed that the bird was seen from the overlook on hiway 316.

On the 22nd in the central at the Saylorville Reservoir, LeConte's Sparrows were seen north of the Cherry Glen area, and in the restored prairie below the dam. In the southeast in Johnson County, several hundred AMERICAN PIPITS were near the end of the Babcock Access Road at the Hawkeye Wildlife Area, while on the 21rst, a PEREGRINE FALCON and MERLIN were seen in the same area.

On the 20th in the northwest in Kossuth County, LECONTE'S SPARROWS, AMERICAN PIPITS, and LAPLAND LONGSPURS were found at the Maynard Reese Waterfowl Production Area.
