(9) In the C in Story Co, a Raven-brown plane was seen on the 28th + 29th on one of the Colo ponds. It was 2 1/2 mi E of Colo on C.R. E-41 + ~~about 1/2 mi south~~ ^{on 29th} it was on the first pond on the S side of the road. Snow was also seen in the SE in Lee Co, 2 WILBILLS were at the Crater Unit of Shrub SF on the 28th. They were in the first valley to the S opposite where the path crosses the stream. - They were about 100 yds in from the parking lot where there were KEYS, CEWS, BROWN ACFT + LOWA. In Iowa on the 29th the COLO were still @ the 546 Quarry along the Sand Road just S of IL.
