ATLANTIC BRANT, Branta bernicla hrota (MULLER). (Formerly American brant.) An Atlantic brant landed with the giant Canada geese in a pen maintained by the State Conservation Commission at Ingham Lake in Emmet County in October, 1970, and was observed there for nearly a month by Commission personnel. In the past, reports of this brant have been considered to be probably mistakes in identification of some of the smaller canadensis group. Specimens are still lacking, but because of the Ingham Lake record the Atlantic brant must now be considered accidental in lowa. Sight observations are listed in Anderson's Birds of lowa and DuMont's Birds of Polk County.
