Weather conditions were bad during Jan. and Feb. With very cold temp. and heavy snow cover.

Red-tailed Hawk: Numbers about the same as past few years.

✓ Rough-legged Hawk: Two sightings on Dec. 2 and Feb. 12.

✓ Bald Eagle: 10 were seen in Saylorville Dan area during late Dec. and early Jan.

✓ Evening Grosbeak: 1 and 2 seen at my feeder every day since Dec. 15.

Purple Finch: Numbers about the same as last year.

Common Redpoll: Numbers up lots of reports at feeders in this area.

Pine Siskin: Very few seen here.

✓ Harris Sparrow: 8 to 10 seen at my feeder everyday, but less than past few years.

~~Snow-Bunting~~: Numbers were up from past couple of years.
