Ross's Goose - 1

Willow Slough, Mills County, Iowa

March 21, 1980

Description: White goose with black primaries. Larger than a Mallard + more robust. Smaller than ~~a~~ other Snow Geese. Head round, neck ~~thin~~ stout. Eye dark. Bill small, conical, ~~a~~ dark pink. No black "gir" mark seen. Feet reddish, ~~bright~~ at base of legs. Rust stain a vertical streak below left wing.

Similar species: Snow Goose! Seemed to differ in size, head shape, bill shape, color of bill (darker w/ Ross's geese) and lack of black gir mark.

Light, etc.: Originally in sunlight, but then cloud hid sun 2:30 pm, looking ESE, and then the bird ~~to~~ moved north. Wind moderate, not a problem. Distance rather far, over 100 yards. Bird on far side of Willow Slough. 40x telescope. Watched the bird over 15 minutes. No books used in field or ~~to~~ to write field notes. This written May 29 from notes ~~not~~ taken March 21.

I've never seen a Ross's Goose before, though I've looked for them.
