The first EASTERN PHOEBES, LONG-BILLED DOWITCHERS, and COMMON LOONS have been reported this past weekend. The week's highlights are GLAUCOUS and LESSER BLACK-BACKED GULLS at Red Rock, and SANDHILL CRANES in the central and northeast.

In the southeast in Marion County at the Red Rock Reservoir on the 24th, an adult GLAUCOUS GULL was at the old Whitebreast beach, a second-winter LESSER BLACK-BACKED GULL was below the dam, and a COMMON LOON was on the lake.

In the southwest in Fremont County, a GOLDEN EAGLE was in the loess hills along the Spring Valley Loop Road about two miles north of Waubonsie State Park, and eleven LONG-BILLED DOWITCHERS were at Secret Lake on the 23rd. In Mills County, a MERLIN was spotted at Willow Slough on the 22nd, and in Pottawattamie County, a GREAT-TAILED GRACKLE was at a pond a mile north of Oakland on the 22nd.

In the central, fourteen TRUMPETER SWANS were reported in Franklin County in a milo patch on the Jensen farm about two miles southeast of Alexander on the 22nd. In Tama County, at least three SANDHILL CRANES have returned to Otter Creek Marsh, where nesting has occurred the past two years. In Polk County at the Saylorville Reservoir, two HORNED GREBES were off the Jester Park boat ramp, and a COMMON LOON was near the mile-long bridge, on the 23rd.

In the northeast in Jackson County on the 23rd, a SANDHILL CRANE, NORTHERN SHRIKE, and 18 species of waterfowl were at the Green Island Wildlife Management Area.
