Bird was flying low over timber headed away from me and was being chased by red-winged blackbirds. The bird did not appear to be a lot larger than the blackbirds. It appeared to be slate gray on the backflwith a long (forthesize of the bird) squarish tail. The square ended tail also appeared slightly notched at the center. The bird had slightly pointed wingtips and flapped a lot and soared and glided very little. Tail was barred with white bands wider than dark. Breast of bird was barred horizontally but I did not note any color since the sun was overhead:
