On April 4, at about 10:30 a.m., I was located one mile south of the Council Bluffs power station. I was driving north on Interstate 29 when I observed a bird chasing a common grackle. It was about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  times the overall size of the grackle. The overall color was medium brown. The axillaries were not darker than the rest of the wing. I did not see a moustache, but the head and underside of the tail were darker than the rest of the body. The tail was long and narrow. The wings were bent at the wrist, and pointed at the tip.

My observation lasted about 10 seconds as the bird flew parallel to me. The bird and grackle flew into a tree where I lost sight of them. I concluded that it was an immature Peregrine Falcon.
