Whistling Swan - ♀

21 March, 1986

Willow Slough, Mills County, Iowa

Description: Big, long necks, black bills. 3 had yellow spots below the eyes on the bills, + the spots were small on one. White.

Behavior: slept, preened, sat there with necks up. In shallow water.

Similar species: Snow Goose: eliminated by size, relative length of neck, and bill color. Trumpeter swan: eliminated by yellow spots on bills.

Location, etc.: the birds were ~~ESE~~ of me on the far side of the slough. It was evening. Not very overcast but I don't remember if the sun was out or not. Evening. 1500 feet away? More? Seen with 20x scope, but yellow spots visible only with the 40x lens. I couldn't see the swans until several hundred Snow/Blue Geese got up + these 5 birds remained behind. Also seen by Maureen Pace. No books used.
