BAIRD'S SANDPIPER
June 9 and June 16, 1983

These "ppeep" had black legs and bills. The wings extended beyond the tail. They were quite buffy around the face, head, and breast. They were, however, a <u>long</u> way away---even with 25x spotting scopes. I do believe they were Baird's (which is perhaps the commenest peep in this area) but you may wish to designate them Calidris species.
