3 white terns were seen flying over Lily Pad with Black Terns. We
Concentrated on the outer wings and primaries. There was an obvious black
wedge on the underside of the forward part of the wing tip. The tips of
the upperwings were slightly darker/same shade of gray as the rest of
upper wing. They lacked the flashy white upperwings of Forster's.
The notch of the tail was not as deep, and the tail was not as long,
as that of Forster's.

We watched the birds for about 10 minutes with L5X-60X Spotting scopes.
