Willow Slough (Oct 20, 24) + Wilson farm, NE
Mills County, Iowa (Oct 21)

^{Oct 20} Description: Tall gray bird with long legs + a bill
that wasn't long. Top of head red. Face white.

Description (Oct 21): Flying over the farm fairly high.
I wouldn't have seen it but it called ~~freely~~ fairly often,
the rolling bugle of cranes. Very large bird with long
wings, parallel front + back, rounded at the tips.
Long legs, held so you could see the space between the
legs (beyond the tail) but the toes were together. Neck
long + outstretched the whole time, + ~~swung~~ the bird
~~turning~~ the head at times. Gray with wingtips black.
Wings darker in the "wingpit" area. Legs darker than body.
Flies with slow ~~flaps~~ flaps + brief glides.

Oct 24: Surely you don't want to hear it again! At
Willow Slough, on the ground.

Behavior: Oct 20: Standing, sometimes preening.
He stayed longer than we did. Oct 24: Flew over going
north west. Later I heard it again - it had turned
back east. Oct 24: Fed in a grassy area by the slough, then
waded out to Pelicans + preened by them.

Similar species: Differs in several ways from Great Blue
Heron.

Viewing conditions: 20x scope, OK distance, looking N or E in
late afternoon at slough, 8X binocs at home. No books
written from notes taken at the times - Barb Wilson
