Also mention voice and behavior. In a mired flock of lesser seaup and oldsquaw. Male was larger sham lesser scaup males by c. 2 inches (c.17-19 inches, est.), and had a dark green head rounded on top, a dark front, white sides, task toil and mottled back. The female had a dark front, rounded head with white at she base of the bill. Her sides were brownish with a darker both, estimated size also 17-19 inches.
Similar species; how eliminated: lesser scaup (size, head shape, head color on male, white sides on wale in direct comparison to lesser scaups. Side by side comparisons with lesser scaup was thankfully easy. The male's rounded head contrasted clearly with the more pointed heads of the lesser scaup. Also, the dork green head of male wasvisible. The male birds sides were white than male lesser scaup's sides and the difference in size was noticable.

Viewing conditions: give lighting, distance (how measured), optical equipment. mostly clear with 20% cloud cover, late afternoon light, 150-200 yords estimated 8 × 40 binoculars and 60 mm scope @ 25-30x. The sun was to our left and believed us as me wohell north at the birds.  Previous experience with species and similar ones: home with greater scamp- lifebird.  familian with lesser scamp.
