THE BIRD HARASSED SEVERAL RING-BULLD GULLS AS I WATCHED AND THE PRIMARIES AND SECONDARIES WERE DARK, THE RUMP WAS LIGHTER THAN THE BACK, AND THE TAIL FEATHERS HAD A PARK BAND WITH THIN WHITE SIMILAR SPECIES and how eliminated:
