Their flights were rather weak-they never flew more than 100 feet, making it rather easy to fligh them again. I saw one of the birds on the ground after it had landed. The back was almost black and the underparts were a butty yellow color. The bill was chicken-like and dark. Leg color was not seen. The birds appeared about the same size as the Soras we flushed that day. the birds were flurhed at different ends of the prairie in a short time period, making it certain that the 2 birds were different birds.
