DETAILS FOR UNUSUAL BIRD SIGHTING

SPECIES: Yellow Rail

LOCATION: North dike at east end of Otter Creek Marsh, Tama County

OBSERVER: Jim Fuller, 6 Longview Knoll, NE, Iowa City, Iowa, 52240

DATE & TIME: 6 May, 1994 (7:05 AM)

DETAILS: I was walking the north dike about 50 yards north of the east parking lot at Otter Creek Marsh, when I flushed a rail which flew east into a wet grassy area, rather than west into the marsh. I had previously flushed or seen about a dozen Soras in the marsh itself, but this bird flushed from on top of the dike. It seemed to be smaller than the Soras that I had flushed, and it also seemed to be a little lighter in color. There were also white wing patches which were very obvious as the bird flew away from me.
