Also mention voice and behavior. We were attempting to flush a Long-eared Owl Afrom a red cedar clump. The owl flew out low, and just behind it, about 10 to 13 feet away a large accipiter, so close the white eye-stripe, dark crown & blue gray back was easily seen. It flew to a tail cotton wood (about 1/8 mile away) where it perched for & minutes first with its back to us, then turning to show its lighter gray underparts (too far away to distinguish the barring) & yellow feet & legs. Its long banded tail hung below the branch. It shook itself exposing the fluffy white undertail coverts. It then flew directly over us & across the lake with its accipiter shape & strong "flap-flap-sail" flight, turning its head one way & another observing below as it flew, appearing solid gray as it passed over. An exciting look at an adult Coshawk!!
Similar species and how eliminated: nothing similar when we saw at such good advantage the gray accipiter with dark crown white eye stripe, the fluffy undertail coverts, darker gray back

Viewing conditions: give lighting, distance (how measured), and optical equipment: Sun behind us, flushed to feet away, flew to cottonwood, about '/s mile away (approximate) - binoculars (unobstructed view).
