Enclosed is a list of bird observations for the winter period, which I know I should have sent to your earlier. Only a couple of them were my own observations, but I'm relaying observations of birds seen by several other people.

I think the early sightings of several species of waterfowl and the red-winged blackbirds is noteworthy, but with the mild weather will probably be typical of observations over the entire state. The earliest red-wings in this area were on February 27, compared to March 15 last year. Local lakes and marshes opened up much earlier than normal. Most of Clear Lake was open by February 26.
