A single observation is furnished by Mrs. F. W. Rice of Des Moines: During the spring of 1915 while leading the class in bird study from Drake University we found this bird caught in a fence near Beaver Creek and were able to observe it at some length. I identified it as a Purple Gaillnule and Dr. Luther S. Ross later checked over my observations. There had been a period of severe storms.

A record of this rare southern specie should be based on a specimen.]
