✓ Gray Partridge	10	Nov. 15	west of Waterloo Greenbelt
✓ Lesser Golden Plover	est. 300	Oct. 12	just west of Tripoli, Ia. with Francis Moore
✓ Baird's Sandpiper	2	Sept. 17	sandpit along Cedar River in Waterloo
✓ Lesser Golden Plover (con't.)	2	Nov. 22	Lake Mac Bride - Russ Hays, Tom Kent, Francis Moore, and Joe Schaufenbuel
✓ Snowy Owl	1	Nov. 26	downtown Waterloo - I did not see bird but it was photographed by Waterloo Courier photographer who I contacted
✓ Long-eared Owl	1 → Oct. 30 5 → Nov. 28		Waterloo Greenbelt Sweet Marsh
✓ Saw-whet Owl	1	Nov. 23	Hartman's Nature Center
✓ Red-breasted Nuthatch	min. of 6	Sept. 16	Sweet Marsh - I have seen many since
✓ Winter Wren	1	Nov. 15	UNI Biology Preserve
✓ Catbird	1	Nov. 28	Volga Lake - (field marks = gray bird - block cap - rusty under tail coverts - dark eyes) with Francis Moore, Joe Schaufenbuel + Stone
✓ Curve-Billed Thrasher	1	Nov. 22	Salon, Ia. - many observers
✓ Water Pipit	6	Oct. 3	Rodger's Lake (north of Vinton)
Warbler migration	many	started Aug. 10	I had an excellent fall migration with many of the normal species seen over the state
Golden-winged Warbler	1	Sept. 7	Red Rock Res.
✓ Evening Grosbeak	25	Nov. 15	Heery Woods - Fantastic study from about 15 ft. on feeding birds
