- Cooper's Hawk--1 on 16 Feb near Ft. Atkinson Winneshale Co Rough-legged Hawk--fairly common this winter
- ✓ Golden Eagle--1 adult in Allamakee Co on 24 Jan
- Com. Snipe--1 on 10 and 24 Jan in YRF Cedar Waxwing -- numerous sightings in Poweshiek and Winneshiek Co's Shrike (sp) -- 2 in Jan in Poweshiek Co, probably Loggerheads

- Com Redpoll--1 at Montezuma on 17 Jan; 12 at Decorah on 24 Jan Pine Siskin--numerous this winter
- ► Red Crossbill -- 6 at Montezuma on 1 Mar Migration of kestrels, killdeer, robins, blackbirds (R-w and Rusty) and meadowlarks started in early Feb in Poweshiek Co.
