## Lewis' Woodpecker

Lewis's Woodpecker at Clear Lake.—I have had a Lewis's Woodpecker eating at a feeding station near my home in Clear Lake, Iowa, during the past winter. The bird was first observed on November 10, 1935, and has been seen daily since then. It is still here (March 2, 1936), and I will take note of the date of its departure. It is a large black woodpecker with a gray band around its neck blending into a robin-red breast. It is about 10½ inches in length and is not at all shy. The only other record of the Lewis's Woodpecker in Iowa appears to be the individual that was seen at Sioux City during the winter of 1928-1929.—F. H.
