AN EXTRAORDINARY SIGHT RECORD

1. Species Peregrine Falcon 2. Number 1
3. Location Muskrat Slough, Jones Co, Iowa

6. Description of size, shape and color-pattern (describe in great detail all parts of the plumage, and beak and feet coloration, in addition, to the diagnostic characteristics, but include only what actually was seen in the field):

Large falcon flew across marsh and landed in tall tree in marsh. We walked through the marsh for 15 min trying to get close to it. Breast and belly appeared very light gray. Head appeared darker with probable face mask - but too far to be clear. When I was at closest point the bird flew. Size about same as ring-billed gull nearby. Long pointed wings with deep fast strong wing beat. In flight appeared dark on wings and back. Flight direct.

7. Description of voice, if heard: N/A

8. Description of behavior: Direct flight in and out of tall tree. Erect posture when sitting.

9. Habitat - general: large marsh

specific: Tree on island on southwest side of Muskrat Slough

10. Similarly appearing species which are eliminated by questions 6, 7 & 8. Explain:
Too large for a merlin. Prairie Falcon very unlikely at this location and time of year. Also bird too dark. Axillaries not specifically seen.

Light overcast. Bird seen against light sky
