Black-bellied Plover -- 1-6 at Montezuma from 2 Sep-13 Oct.

Sanderling--4 at Red Rock Res. on 27 Sep; 1 at Montezuma on 30 Sep.

Caspian Tern--1-11 at Montezuma from 8 Sep-1 Oct.

Whip-poor-Will--1 at Montezuma on 24 Sep.

Red-breasted Nuthatch--many observed this fall.
Winter Wren--3 at L&D#9 on 3 Oct; 1 at Montezuma on 6 Oct.
White-eyed Vireo--1 at Montezuma on 7 Sep.

Evening Grosbeak -- 16 at Montezuma on 11 Nov; 6 at Castalia on 24 Nov Pine Siskin -- many flocks observed this fall.
