Rick Hollis has urged me to tell you our experience with siskins in the last few weeks. On November 9, a female siskin came near our feeder. I had some difficulty identifying it because the front stripes weren't quite right and there was no sign of yellow on the bird. Apparently the same bird was back on November 16. It was joined by two other siskins on that date. On November 22 and 23, there were about 20 siskins at our feeder. These were still there on November 29 and 30, and we actually counted 27 siskins on the 30th. All of these observations are for the farm at Oxford, Iowa.
