The bird had a gray-buffy breast turning to light orange rust on the lower flanks, belly, and undertail coverts. The beak was all black flycatcherlike with a hooked end to the upper mandilbe. The bird had small black whiskers at the base of the bill. The eyes were black with a sideways diamondlike black eyeline. The back and wing was gray with indistinct whitish primary and secondary wing coverts and tertial bars. The tail was darker than the back, pure black and very weakly forked. The bird was smaller than a Robin about the size of a bluebird.
