- ✓ Bell's Vireo--at least 7 singing males in Poweshiek Co during Jun-Jul
- ✓ Black and White Warbler--1 at Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on 6 Jun
- ✓ Worm-eating Warbler--1 in Shimek S.F. on 7 Jun
- ✓ Northern Parula--1 in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on 6 Jun

- ✓ Louisiana Waterthrush--7 in White Pine Hollow S.Pres. on 20 Jun; also found in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P.; Shimek S.F.; and Pikes Peak S.P. in Jun
- ✓ Kentucky Warbler--found in all the usual places
- ✓ Yellow-breasted Chat--1 in Lacy-Keosauqua S.P. on 6 Jun; 1 in Shimek S.F. on 7 Jun; 2 near Barnes City on 11 Jun; 1 near Marquette on 21 Jun; 1 near Searsboro on 1 Jul
- ✓ Canada Warbler--3 singing males in White Pine Hollow S.Pres. on 20 Jun
- ✓ Am. Redstart--41 along 2½ miles creek near Marquette on 21 Jun
- ✓ Orchard Oriole--at least 8 singing males in Poweshiek Co during Jun-Jul
- ✓ Swamp Sparrow--4 at Otter Creek Marsh on 17 Jun
