IV, Apparently 2 observers (SP & EF), no description, no details, observers credible.

III, Very reliable observer makes this III rather than IV, although age of birds not being mentioned introduces some doubt.

Audubon Field Notes 1963 17:328 Gulls—Glaucous Gulls were found at St. Louis on Jan. 12 (SH); March 7, two birds (WG & MW): March 9, four birds (EC). All were in second year plumage. Two Great Black-backed Gulls appeared on the Mississippi at Moline, Ill., Feb. 10 (SP & EF). At Lakewood, Ohio, a Franklin's Gull was present for the month of December (OD).
