American Tree Sparrow numbers 31 Oct s.e. Hardin Co grave / pit - seen by PHonly White-throated Spanew" part of the large amount of Sparrows seen this date, including also fewer numbers of Lark, Chipping, Harris, Fox, Savannah + Song Sparrows. Many white-throated, several fax + a few Harris seen by MP at Grammar Grove this date also. Two days of heavy migration could be weather-related. On Aug 28 we noted a big influx of warblers + vireos. The day before there were strong northerly winds with gusts to 25, + the day following we received 1.4" rain. Were the birds influenced by the north winds the preceding day, or flying ahead of the rain coming in ?? Unother period was Oct 30 with 1000's of blackbirds, and Oct 31 with hordes of sparrows. The preceding week had been beautiful, except for Oct 28 when we had steady rain totalling I". The day following, Now, had vain, some heavy, throughout our area, with snow on Nov 3 +4 + temperatures 150-200 colder than normal. This was the period when northern Minnesote, Wisconsin + the UP of Michigan received from 20" to 2 feet of snow. I would assume the birds were moving ahead of that. - BPr.
