DeSoto Refuge received the Prairie falcon on Sept. 25, the same day that it came in to our raptor rehab. program. I don't know the date it was found at Pisgah or who found it. One wing was be ond repair & the condition of the bird was poor when we received it. It died at the vet's on 9/27.

This seemed like an early date for a prairie falcon. I think we usually begin seeing them in mid October.

On the shorebirds -- this is the latest we've ever had shorebirds around here. However, it was the first year we've had a really good area for them - the sludge ponds.
