VI, 2nd hand report, 2 observers who were familiar with 'Boattailed Grackle'. No description nor any differential diagnosis from the more likely Great-tailed Grackle. In early 1960, the Great-tail was breeding extensively in Okla - e. g. Birds of Okla by Sutton.

IV, rather sketchy details.

A. Sight Record of the Boat-tailed Grackle. Miss C. Esther Copp of Wheatland reports that she and her sister Dolly, while fishing on October 18, 1961, were attracted by a voice which was unfamiliar in their woods. The bird responsible for the strange sounds was observed perching in nearby shrubs, on the ground and in flight at a distance of 50 feet. Miss Copp, who has observed Boat-tailed Grackles in New Orleans, identified the bird as one of this species. The Boat-tailed Grackle, while a common bird in the South, has not previously been recorded in Iowa according to Jack Musgrove.— WOODWARD BROWN, 4815 Ingersoll Ave., Des Moines.
