

Great Gray Owl in N. E. Iowa -- While driving down Highway 9, towards Decorah, I spotted an owl on the opposite side of the road at a point 5.5 miles west of the Postville Road. It was the fifteenth of February, 1974. I turned the car around and approached the owl. I got out of the car and started snapping off pictures as I approached the bird. I got within ten feet of it before it flew away.

I thought that I was fairly well versed on my owl identifications, but could not key this bird down. I noted its size, breast markings and yellow eyes and proceeded to Decorah. Once back in Wisconsin I was able to obtain an identification on the bird and the pictures confirmed my identification of this Great Gray Owl.
