Similar species and how eliminated: The fact that the bird's back had absolutely no dark streaking eliminates bay-breated and blackpoll worklers. The lack of the obvious yellow "spectades", bill shope, "presence of faint streaks on the sides eliminates yellow-throated vires. Did any one disagree or have reservations about identification? NO
