

## Brief Documentation of unusual species:

- ① Gr. Wh-Front Goose - This bird has been seen by many observers at Springlake Park in Cherokee. IT is with several hundred Canadas. IT has the white around the base of the bill, speckled belly and orange legs. Smaller than giant Canadas. Seen day of count by ~~me~~ Dick Bierman.
- ② Hermit Thrush - Responded to owl tape. Areal surprise! First time on our count. IT was in full view. 30' away. spotted breast <sup>short</sup> rusty tail & rump. dull brown otherwise with creamy spotted breast. IT even exhibited the typical cocking of the tail. Seen by me & 2 others.
- ③ Yellow Rumped Warbler - Seen in area found for 3 weeks. Responded to owl tape. Found in mixed Cedar Oak edge. Yellow rump and dull yellow patch before each wing. Small. Flighty. Typical fall plumage. Check for possible Audubons Race but they weren't. Seen by me and 3 others.
