Note: this bird was seen within 100 feet of where the immature Prairie Warbler was seen Aug. 12, 1986.

I observed a wood warbler-sized bird about 6 feet off the ground in a small tree. The bird had a bright yellow breast and undersides, extending from throat to tail. Along the sides only were blackish streaks, but not so pronounced as on a male bird-overall, this bird looked like a faded male Prairie Warbler. Both the black supercilliar and malar streaks were evident, with yellow in between--again quite similar to the a male, but the black was not as black(as on a male) and the streaks were not as bold, but nevertheless conspicuous.

The back of the bird was uniformly green-brown from crown to tail. I had a good view of the back but observed no chestnut streaking.

The bird pumped its tail continuously as I watched it.

Similar species and how eliminated:

In view of the features I observed, I considered this bird pretty much in the unmistakable category. Did anyone disagree or have reservations about the identification? No.
