LOCATION: along the Des Moines River in extreme SC Webster Co. DETAILS: Bird was robin sized or slightly smaller. Breast, back, head, and tail were gray except for a buffy patch on each wing. These patches were seen in flight and while the bird was perched. White outer tail feathers were also seen in flight. The bird also had a bold white eye-ring. The bill and legs were dark. The bird was enticed to respond to a tape-the call was a long tittering warble. While under observation, the bird made several short flycatcher-like flights to catch insects.
