Cape May Warblers

On Sept. 16, 1984 we watched two Cape May warblers from 9 - 9:30 a.m. feeding in cedar trees at the Martin Chapel cemetery in Mills Co.

They were both females. The throat and sides of throat were yellow to orange-yellow; pale yellow breast to white on belly; heavy dark streaking on breast & sides; white undertail coverts; yellow rump. Back was olive green with dark brown streaks. Top of head was grayish-brown with fine dark streaking. Large grayish ear patches with a dark line through the eye. Had one light, thin wing bar.

Viewed from 15 to 50 ft with Nikon 9x25; Bushnell Custom Compact 6x25. binoculars.
